"Research that relies on verbal data is called qualitative research, while research that relies on numerical data is called quantitative research [emphasis original]" (Charles, p. 30). Various opinions exist, depending on one's viewpoint, experience, or preference, about which of the two major approaches to education research, qualitative or quantitative, is better.

Qualitative Versus Quantitative Methods in Education ...

Qualitative research approaches help to define what needs to be studied when there is no theory on the topic and variables are not known (Leedy and Ormrod, 2014), as opposed to quantitative approaches that use theory to generate data.

The Usefulness of Qualitative and Quantitative Approaches ...

Quantitative research deals with numbers and statistics, while qualitative research deals with words and meanings. Quantitative methods allow you to test a hypothesis by systematically collecting and analyzing data, while qualitative methods allow you to explore ideas and experiences in depth.

Broadly speaking, there are three distinct approaches to connecting research—quantitative, qualitative and mixed methods. Creswell (2014) considers research designs to be different types of inquiry within these different approaches which Denzin and Lincoln (2011, cited in Creswell, 2014, p. 12) called "strategies of inquiry".
