total gross annual household income must be less than or equal to 185% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) (see below); and. 2) You must also spend more than 3% of your income for electric service or more than 3% of your income for natural gas service.

Universal Service Fund (USF) - New Jersey

USF is a program created by the State of New Jersey to help make natural gas and electric bills more affordable for low-income households. If you are eligible, USF can lower the amount you pay for gas and electricity. To be eligible, a household gross income must be at or below 175% of the Federal Poverty Level, (please refer to income guidelines listed below), and pay more than 3% of its annual income for electric, or more than 3% for natural gas.

LIHEAP Requirements - NJPowerOn

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is designed to help low-income families and individuals meet home heating and medically necessary cooling costs. To be eligible, a household must have a gross income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level and be responsible for the cost of heating.
