Tansy, garlic, and rue are said to help deter Japanese beetles. Planting linden trees or geraniums may act as trap crops, luring Japanese beetles away from blackberries. Avoid planting blackberries near conifers, such as pine trees, as blackberry psyllid overwinter in the conifers, but attack the blackberry leaves.

Plants recommended for companion planting with tomatoes include amaranth, asparagus, basil, bean, borage, calendula (pot marigold), carrots, celery, chive, cleome, cosmos, cucumber, garlic, lemon balm, lettuce, marigold, mint, nasturtium, onion, parsley, peas, sage, stinging nettle, sow thistle, and squash. Amaranth helps repel insects.
